

Robert and Kathleen Lott
2013 Grand Marshalls

Sixth Generation Lehi Residents, Robert (Bud) and Kathleen Lott have been named as the 2013 Grand Marshalls for the Lehi City Celebration.

Bud and Kathleen grew up together in Lehi, attending the same LDS Ward, Lehi Elementary, Junior High and High School. They were married in the Salt Lake Temple on April 29, 1955 and have lived in Lehi ever since.

Bud worked for Geneva Steel, then spent thirty-two years at Hercules (now ATK) in Magna. Kathleen stayed home with the children as they grew, serving as a 4-H leader and becoming an accomplished seamstress and cook.

Both of the Lotts have been very involved in Lehi community organizations. Kathleen served in the PTA and is currently serving as an officer in the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers. Bud was a member of the Riding Club and served as a Director on the Civic Improvement Association for many years.

Bud and Kathleen have also been very active in the LDS Church. They have served in almost every organization from Relief Society to Primary and, following Bud's retirement, he and Kathleen

served two missions to Nauvoo, Illinois and worked in the Mt. Timpanogos temple.

Today, Bud's hobby is the "Hardway" Ranch, so named because it's too small for a tractor, but too big for a shovel, so everything has to be done the "Hard Way". This six acre property in south Lehi has hosted many reunions, youth conferences, scout meetings and community gatherings. He's been working on it since they purchased the property in 1996 and he adds buildings or improvements every year.

Bud and Kathleen enjoy riding horses. Bud has been a farrier for many years, but thinks he should give it up in 2014 when he turns 80. He remembers his first rodeo, when he was asked to ride a contestant's horse to the rodeo grounds and so got a free ticket in. Kathleen thinks her parents took her to the first rodeo in Lehi as a baby, and except for their mission, they haven't missed a rodeo since. Bud and Kathleen represent the best of Lehi and we are honored to have them serve as the Grand Marshalls in 2013.
