### Literacy Center

Our winter after-school session begins this month and runs through February, and our fall ABC Program will be ending December 11 and 12. Open registration for the spring ABC Program will be open on our website December 2 until classes are full. There will be no ABC or After-School classes during the ASD Winter Break Dec 23 through January 2.

Literacy Center after-school programs offer reading and math classes for Lehi students in K - 4th grade. Classes are 45 minutes, twice a week, either Mon/Wed OR Tues/Thurs. ### Streets

#### **Parking and Snow Removal**

Please be aware that parking on city streets during or for 24 hours following a snow storm is prohibited by Lehi City municipal code. In addition, from November 1 to March 30, parking on a city street is prohibited from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Lehi Streets Division will prioritize snow removal on city streets during and after a storm. On average, the division plows 4,000 lane miles of road per storm. The Streets Division will begin with roads that receive the most traffic and then plow roads in residential neighborhoods.
