| Apartment |  | A building containing two or more residential units, under one ownership |
| Articulation |  | Adding breaks or changes in the depth of the plane or form of the building façade and/or footprint into more human-scale components |
| Awning |  | Rooflike shelter over a doorway, window, porch, or deck |
| Balcony |  | A platform that projects from a wall and is enclosed by a railing |
| Bay Window |  | A window projecting outward from main walls |
| Belt Course |  | A continuous row or layer of stones, brick, or change in materials |
| Cornice |  | Ornamental molding |
| CMU |  | Concrete masonry unit. A standard size rectangular block used in building construction. |

| Dormer Window |  | Roofed window that projects vertically beyond the plane of a pitched roof. |
| EIFS |  | Exterior Insulation and Finish Systems. Non-load bearing, exterior wall cladding system that consists of an insulation board attached either adhesively or mechanically, or both, to the substrate |
| Entrance |  | The point at which a visitor perceives and interacts with the experience of a specific environment |
| Facade |  | The face of a building, especially the principal front that looks onto a street or open space |
| Gable |  | Triangular portion of a wall between the edges of intersection roof pitches |
| Mullion |  | A vertical element that forms a division between units of a window, door, or screen, or is used decoratively |
| Pilaster |  | Ornamental feature that gives the appearance of a supporting column |
| Townhome |  | A multi-story house in a modern housing development which is attached to one or more similar houses by shared walls |
