Notes Classes will begin promptly at 7:00a.m. The **Lifesaving** Merit Badge will require the scouts to be dressed with denim jeans or some type of pants with long pant legs, a shirt that they can get into the swimming pool with and a pair of goggles, as they will swim underwater.

*A 500 yard non-stop swim at the beginning of class is a pre-requisite for **both** Merit Badges. Please provide transportation home when the class is over, or if they cannot complete the swim. Scouts are required to bring a swim suit, with a towel and goggles. Any scout masters or assistants are welcome to help and would be appreciated.

REGISTRATION

Register *only* at the outdoor pool (451 E. 200 S. Lehi) during public swim hours beginning June 3. No registration at the Legacy Center.
