Photography Eagle Projects

There are fourteen Photograph Eagle Projects. One of these Projects can use four different Eagle Projects (Business Photography) Presently Eleven of these deal with Photography and can be used by all the boys for the Photography Merit Badge. (Requirement #4). (Six of these are in the process of being completed. There are also two more positions available for the Business Photography #1) The boys will take photographs and will be required to provide the photographs and provide them on a CD as a whole and an individual print of each photo, Also they will be required to write up a description, the date, and information about each photo.

Project #3 Photographic Documentation of Lehi City buildings and structures

Project #10 Detailed Photograph of Lehi State Street

This Scout will go down State street and document the precise spot of each business. It will include photographs of the individual businesses, photograph of sections of State Street(both sides) photographs of large views of State Street as of 2013. Afterward the Scout will produce a map with locations of the businesses, vacant lots and other items on State Street with correct addresses and descriptions.

The Scout will provide: A copy of the Map, A three ring binder with scanned photos and descriptions of the photograph, hard copy of each photograph and the photographs on a Disk.

Project #11 Detailed Photography of the Jordan River

This Scout will document all the spots, scenery, road crossings, from the Lake to the point of the mountain. The Scout will provide approximately 100 photographs of the Jordan River and surrounding areas in Utah County. These can include the Jordan River walking path that follows the River. As with all photographic projects, the Scout will need to provide three components with the project: A hard copy print of each of the photographs; A copy of all the photographs on a disc; and a three ring binder with a plastic page for each photograph-Each page has a scanned photograph with a description, date and documentation of each photograph.

Project #12 Detailed Photograph of the Shores of Utah Lake in the Northern Part of Utah County.

This Scout will document all the spots, sights, shores, parks scenery along Utah Lake. The scout will concentrate on Northern Utah county. The Scout will provide approximately 100 photographs of Utah Lake and its scenery in hard copy, an information sheet on each photo including a scanned photo in plastics sheets in a three ring binder, and all the photographs on disc. This project may take all three seasons to complete it.

Project #13 Detailed Photograph of Thanksgiving Point, the Museum, the shops, the animals, the sights and the Gardens.

This Scout will document all the spots, sights, gardens, parks, shops, museums, animals, and rooms of Thanksgiving Points. The scout will document all areas of

Thanksgiving Point in 2013. The Scout will provide at least and approximately 100 photographs of Thanksgiving Point and its scenery in hard copy, an information sheet with a scanned photo on each page in a three ring binder , and all the photographs on a disc.

Project #14 Photography of the trees of Lehi.

This Scout will document all the beautiful old trees of Lehi. The Scout will document where the trees are located and approximate the age of the trees. The Scout will provide at least and approximately 100 photographs of trees around Lehi. They will provide the pictures in hard copy, an information sheet with a scanned photo one each page (in plastic containers in 3 ring binder) , and all the photographs on a disc.

Historical Projects

There are seven projects dealing with the History of Scouting and the History of Lehi. One Scout will work on coming up with the history of Scouting in Lehi; another a collection of historical Scout Patches. Two others will work with other scouts in making a historical time line using one of the two histories of Lehi. Another Scout will scan the Biographies from the Lehi 1945 History Book and print out individual sheets for each biography for the Archives Biographical Files. Another will obtain Biographies from Lehi and another will print and apply labels to the historical files at the Archives.

Project #15. Historical Scouting Artifacts of Lehi collection for the Lehi City Archives

This Scout Project will be to work on the history of Scouting in Lehi. Scout will contact each ward asking any ward members to donate stories, information, copy of photographs, documents, camp programs, award banquet memorabilia that could be donated for the Scouting history of Lehi. Scout will identify and contact and interview key scouters from history, to have them write their stories and events of Scouting in Lehi down. These stories, photographs will be saved in the Lehi Archives for Scouters to access in the future. This will be a great service to Scouting and to Lehi.

Project #15 Utah National Boy Scout Patch Collection to be housed at the Lehi Archives

The Project will be to collect as many Utah National Parks Patches from the history of Boy Scouting in Lehi. The Scouts will start canvass Lehi, Scout organizations, wards, Scout Leaders and others to donate patches to start a historical collection of Scout patches use by Scouts in Lehi. These will be displayed at the Archives so that Scouts can view and add to the collection.

Project #16 Lehi: Portrait of a Utah Town by Richard Van Wagoner Timeline

The Project is to divide the chapters of the book among those helping you and to make a timeline of the happenings in Lehi from the book. This timeline will become a document of Lehi History that will be published and made available to the Citizens of Lehi on their history. This is a very important project and will be an important part of the Lehi Archives.

The dates will be documented and put in order from the oldest to the newest.

Project #18 Gardner History of Lehi Biography Scan

The Scouts will take the Biography Section of the History of Lehi and scan the pages into a computer including the photographs. This will be given to the archives on a disk.

The Scouts will then print out each of the biography of each person

individually including the picture. These will be placed in a Historical files of residents of Lehi.

Project #19 Collect Biographies of Residents of Lehi

The Scout will try to collect from 50-100 biographies of Lehi Residents (Intended for those who have died but can also include Senior Citizens of Lehi at the current time) The Individual Biographies can contain copy of obituaries, family photographs, individual photographs, pictures of their homes, occupation and any other items about the individual. Items such as patriarchal blessings, genealogy sheets, funeral programs, photographs from all eras of their lives, and other special items can also be included

These biographies will be kept in an individual file for each person for protection and preserving the histories for future generations. Future generations will be able to come to the Lehi Archives to find out about their ancestors.

Project #20 File Folder Labels

All the files at the Archives are in need of computer prepared file folder labels. We will need one on the Manila Folder of each file and the other on the green hanging folders. The plastic form we use on the hanging folders are provided and are at the Archives.

The Listing of the Archives files are all typed and on a google document and can be emailed to the Scout.

The Scout will obtain the File folder labels for the manila folders and print them out. The Scouts will apply them to each of the files so they look professional

They will also put little stickers into the plastic containers for the identification on the green hanging folders. The Scouts will also connect these to the proper place on the green hanging folders. This will be a great help to the Archives.

Woodworking Projects

Project #21 Wood Holder for blueprints, plans and maps.

We have a woodworking project. The Archives has a bunch of plat maps, blueprints of the Lehi Memorial Building, Old Lehi High School, Tabernacle, and other buildings, churches and schools. We need a wood box that can securely hold these plot plans in tubes to protect them. The scout will raise the money for the project, construct it and finish the holder for approximately 50 tubes. These old blueprints are wide and necessary for larger than normal tubes.

Project #22 Wood Holder for oversized photographs

This will save hundreds of pictures from damage.

Project #23-25 Lehi Free Press bound Holders

The bound historic Lehi Free Press are moving to the Lehi City Archives. We need three Scouts to build three holders for the Bound Historical Lehi Free Presses. We will need these to be built like the ones at the Library which currently hold them. The Librarians will show the Scout and Leaders the book shelves that need to be copied.

These will be a lasting project for the Archives and the Lehi Free Press.

Project #26-27 Book Cases for Oversized Books

The Archives are in need of two large bookcases to hold over-sized books. The Scout will raise money for and build two large bookcases for the Archives to hold very old and expensive historical books.

Histories of the Local Schools

There is a project to document the historical history of the Lehi High School.

Project #28 Lehi High School Historical Listing

Scout will gather a historical listing of the following items for each year for each category:

- Principals and Vice-Principals of Lehi High School
- Studentbody Presidents and Studentbody Officers
- Cheerleaders
- Homecoming Queen and Kings
- Senior Class Officers
- Total Number of Students
- Students broken Down by Class

- Trophies won by the School per year
- Plays and Performances highlight of each year
- Basketball, Baseball, Soccer, Tennis, Football and Golf Coaches.
- Win Loss Record Per sport.

Each of these categories will be on a separate sheet showing the details from all the years of Lehi High School History. Information can be retrieved from the yearbooks and histories at the High School.
